What benefit do you gain by interfering between the scholars?

Shaykh Muhammad Amaan Al-Jaamee:

None of this is from the etiquettes of Dawah, nor is it from the etiquettes of rectification; rather its provocation, confusion, and agitating the youth. I have said this before. And what I said before I say it now; and I'll say it later.

The one who refutes and debates; he is the Shaykh. The Shaykh—all praises belong to Allah—is still alive.

So we advise our students not to get involved in matters between the students of knowledge and the scholars.

If a Shaykh accuses a Shaykh of falling into error, the response comes from the Shaykh.

As for you, why are you exhausting yourself?

What benefit do you gain by interfering between the scholars?

You will only fall into backbiting, and slandering the scholars, and students of knowledge.

You will not gain any benefit at all, rather you will lose!

For this reason we advise our youth to stay for away from this position. It is not appropriate for them.
