

﴿١٢٤﴾ وَمَنْ يَعْمَلْ مِنَ الصَّالِحَاتِ مِنْ ذَكَرٍ أَوْ أُنْثَىٰ وَهُوَ مُؤْمِنٌ فَأُولَٰئِكَ يَدْخُلُونَ الْجَنَّةَ وَلَا يُظْلَمُونَ نَقِيرًا

And whoever does righteous good deeds, male or female, while he is a believer, such will enter Paradise and not the least injustice, even to the size of a Naqīra, will be done to them. (Soorah An-Nisā' 4:124)

Shaykh Abdul Muhsin said: The Naqīra refers to the small dot of the back of the kernel of the date.



﴿٧٧﴾ وَلَا تُظْلَمُونَ فَتِيلًا

And you shall not be dealt with unjustly even equal to a Fatīla. (Soorah An-Nisā' 4:77)

Shaykh Abdul Muhsin said: The Fatīla is the thread in the slit of a date stone.



﴿١٣﴾ وَالَّذِينَ تَدْعُونَ مِنْ دُونِهِ مَا يَمْلِكُونَ مِنْ قِطْمِيرٍ

And those, whom you invoke or call upon instead of Him, own not even a Qitmīr (Soorah Fāḥir 35:13)

Shaykh Abdul Muhsin said: The Qitmīr refers to the thin membrane over the date-stone.
